

Market performance

- All equity market regions posted positive gains in March. The best performer was the UK delivering +4.4% return. Bond markets were also positive, with the expectation that central banks may cut interest rates through the year, as inflation continues to decline. Inflation is certainly on the right path but may still encounter challenges. Equity markets have started the year very strongly with both Japan and the US markets being the standouts, both delivering double digit returns in the first quarter.
- The March Budget was delivered in the UK and the messaging was positive Britain's recession is over; inflation is under control and interest rates will be cut. There have been fears that the UK economy could stagnate or deliver a sluggish recovery. However, the independent office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) thinks that the UK's recession, which saw growth contracting in the second half of last year, is over and that activity will pick up from here. The OBR forecasts by the end of the year, the UK economy will be growing above trend. The mood music felt much more positive than what the market has been used to and this helped drive the stock market higher. The UK market is one we favour as valuations are still looking attractive, notably as we look down the market cap spectrum and stocks with UK domestic exposure.
- The US market continued to power ahead. The fourth quarter earnings season did not deliver sparkling results, but declining input costs saw margin expansion for many firms. The strong performance and high valuations for the market have caused many investors to question whether US equities are in a bubble. Unsurprisingly, there are dissenting views. The US technology sector has come under the spotlight and the epitome of this is Nvidia. Those that own the stock argue the rapid adoption of Artificial Intelligence (AI), has and will continue to result in an explosion of demand for their advanced semi-conductors. While sceptics highlight the valuations of the stock and draw parallels with the Tech Boom we saw at the end of the 1990's and the subsequent implosion of the technology bubble.
- European equity markets were not far behind the US & UK delivering a +3.5% return. The inflation outlook and the macroeconomic picture showed a situation where rate cuts were likely and the recessionary fears are less likely to materialise than previously thought.
- Bond yields contracted through March, delivering positive returns for both corporate and government bonds. While other asset classes such as infrastructure, which has interest rate sensitivity, delivered positive returns of +2.3%. However, concerns persist as inflation appears to be stabilising at a level notably higher than the 2% target set by central banks.
- We have seen a positive start to the year for equity markets, but the road ahead will likely be bumpy as we navigate macroeconomic and geopolitical pitfalls. What has also been interesting has been the strength of gold so far this year, an asset class and investment generally used from a defensive standpoint. Gold returned +8.5% in March which is part driven by the expectation of interest rate cuts in the US, which may see the dollar weaken. The other factor for the gold price strength has been the flight to safety in the light of geopolitical concerns.

Risk Barometer



Based on our proprietary Prediction Algorithm the Copia Risk Barometer is reading +0.42 as of 29-Mar-2024, a change of +0.09 from last month, staying in the green zone, indicating that the global economic outlook remains positive.

Primary drivers for the Risk Barometer:

- **Government bond markets:** Despite major global yield curves remaining inverted, the extent of inversion has narrowed from the levels seen for throughout 2023. This is an encouraging signal from bond markets, suggesting an increased likelihood of rate cuts in developed markets this year.
- **Equity market pricing:** Following Federal Reserve Powell's unexpected dovish comments, investors are pricing in expectations that the Fed is likely done raising rates. This has been a positive signal for markets with equity market momentum rising over the past quarter.
- **Credit Spreads:** Credit spreads have continued to tighten, indicating corporate bond investors are not pricing in a systemic default of the bonds and signalling a lower probability of recession.
- **Overall:** The overall signals from both equity and fixed income have improved. Leading to the Risk Barometer providing a positive outlook towards risk assets.

Risk Barometer history

- The top chart shows the market performance (best and worst returns) during different Risk Barometer regimes.
- The bottom chart shows how the Risk Barometer has moved between different regimes and the triggers for regime changes.
- The Risk Barometer is a forward-looking quantitative model that provides a systematic rules-based approach for dynamic risk management.







Impact of dynamic risk management using the Risk Barometer

- Objective is to achieve similar levels of returns, with a narrower dispersion of returns (reduced tail risk)
- Can enhanced risk-adjusted returns
- Can deliver a smoother investment journey whilst mitigating downside risk
- We evaluate impact using a theoretical 60/40 portfolio with and without the Risk Barometer





Outcome (risk-return) analysis as of 29 March 2024








